

## Traillager of the Year

## LAUREN HAMMOND FORMER CITY COUNCILMEMBER





Tonight, we honor a remarkable woman whose legacy has forever transformed Sacramento: Lauren Hammond, the first Black woman elected to the Sacramento City Council. Her groundbreaking election in 1997 broke barriers and set a precedent for future generations of women leaders in our community.

Born and raised in Sacramento, Lauren's journey in public service began at a young age. Influenced by the unrest of the Watts riots in 1965, she made a vow to create meaningful change in people's lives. This commitment to justice and equity shaped her career path, leading her to represent District on the council for 13 years, fiercely advocating for underserved communities.

Beyond her time in office, Lauren remained a pivotal figure in shaping California's political landscape. She was a mentor, a champion for diversity, and a fierce advocate for women in leadership. As the leader of the Sacramento chapter of the National Women's Political Caucus, she worked tirelessly to recruit and train women candidates, ensuring that her legacy of empowerment lived on.

Her impact on Sacramento is immeasurable. Lauren Hammond was more than a trailblazer; she was a beacon of hope, courage, and resilience. As we present this award tonight, we not only celebrate her achievements but also recognize the lasting influence she has had on all of us.

She may be gone, but her legacy lives on in every life she touched and every barrier she broke. We are honored to remember her tonight and to celebrate a life dedicated to the service of others.

This award is accepted by her wife, Margaret Maher, and her sister, Carol Hammond, as we honor Lauren's indelible mark on our city and beyond.




